Duke is a beautifully presented 60ft traditional stern narrowboat that will immediately appeal to anyone seeking an authentic boating experience. Finished in a sumptuous forest green livery with elegant gold accents, she perfectly combines wonderful canal heritage with modern liveaboard comforts.

At the heart of Duke is her lovingly maintained 1960 Lister HA2 engine, housed in a dedicated engine room where it can be fully appreciated. The distinctive sound and character of this classic engine are sure to delight enthusiasts, while the traditional layout and decorative details throughout the boat create a timeless atmosphere rarely found in modern craft.

Entering from the stern, you step into a charming boatman's cabin, beautifully decorated with whimsical Roses and Castles artwork that celebrates the traditions of the inland waterways. This cosy cabin features a drop-down cross bed and a gorgeous coal-burning stove, making it an inviting retreat on cooler evenings.

Beyond the boatman's cabin lies the engine room, where the impressive Lister HA2 takes pride of place. This practical space also houses the batteries, a Victron inverter charger and a 4G signal booster.

The main bedroom is generously sized and offers a comfortable double berth, storage cupboards and the added benefit of a radiator, creating a warm and relaxing space for extended cruising or residential use.

The bathroom is fitted with a cassette toilet, wash basin, curtain-screened shower and a 240-volt washing





machine, providing all the conveniences required for life afloat.

Moving forward, the well-equipped galley offers ample worktop space and storage alongside a gas cooker, under-counter fridge and sink with drainer, making meal preparation easy whether you're away for a weekend or a longer journey.

At the bow of the boat, the spacious saloon provides a comfortable and welcoming living area. A sofa bed offers additional sleeping accommodation, while the diesel stove ensures year-round comfort. The saloon also benefits from a television and an impressive sound system comprising a pre-amplifier, subwoofer and four roof-mounted speakers, creating an excellent entertainment space.

Steps lead from the saloon onto the cratch-covered bow deck, providing a pleasant outdoor seating area from which to enjoy the ever-changing canal scenery.

Duke was last blacked in 2025 and benefits from a Boat Safety Certificate valid until August 2028, offering peace of mind for her next owner.

Full of warmth, charm and traditional character, Duke is a wonderful example of a classic narrowboat. With her historic engine, beautifully decorated features and comfortable accommodation, she offers a rare opportunity to own a truly distinctive craft that celebrates the heritage of Britain's canals while remaining practical for modern cruising.

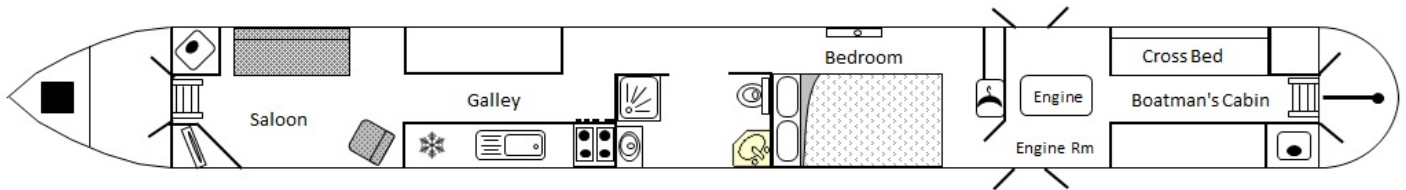
