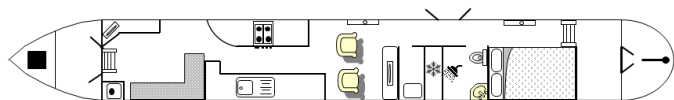

The bathroom follows, equipped with a shower, basin, and toilet, offering all the essential facilities in a compact, well-designed space. Just beyond is a small but useful utility room, fitted with a fridge and washing machine—making extended stays on board all the more convenient.

Kate's galley is well laid out, with a sink and drainer unit, a diesel range cooker, ample worktop space, and plenty of undercounter storage. It's a practical and welcoming area for preparing meals while enjoying life afloat.

The dinette is situated at the front of the boat and offers an inviting space with an L-shaped sofa, a second TV, and a diesel stove for warmth and atmosphere. 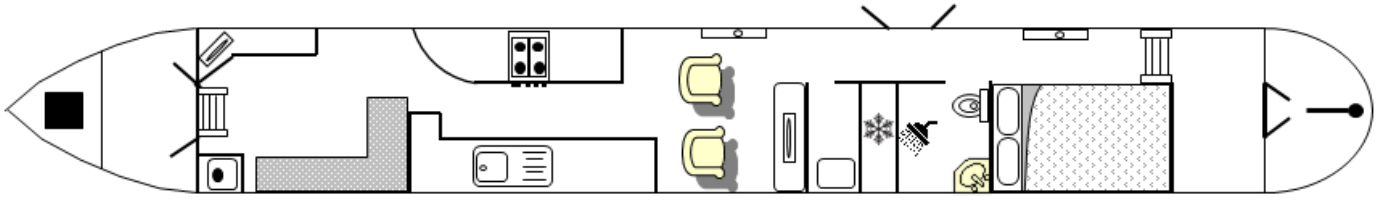
