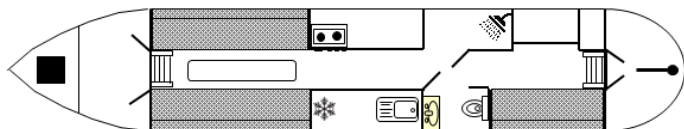
The galley is well-equipped with a cooker, hob, fridge, and sink – everything you need to whip up a meal while afloat.

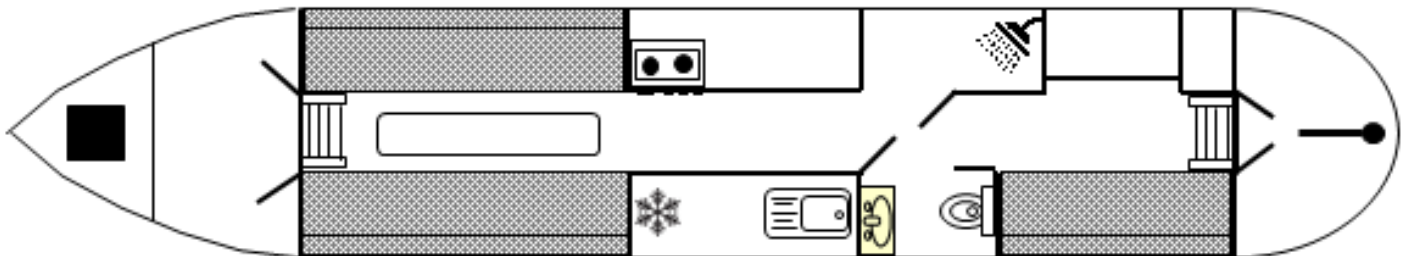
